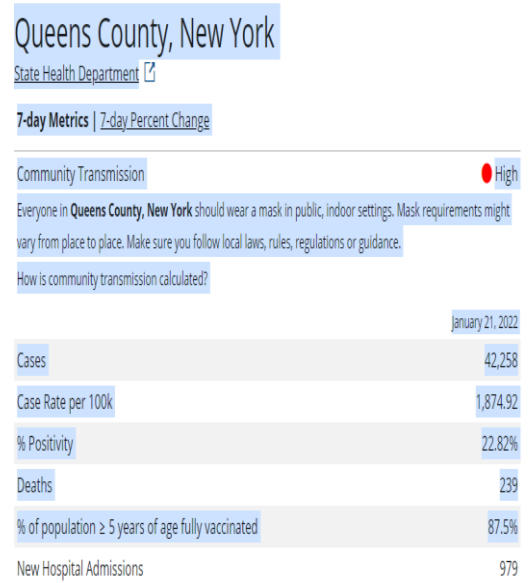

Visiting at Chapin Home, adhering to CMS and Dept. of Health regulations and guidance, which requires all visitors to submit the results of a COVID negative test to enter the facility. PCR results must not be older than two days prior to visiting (48 hours). Antigen (Rapid) results must not be older than one day (24 hours) prior to visiting. Chapin Home is unable to conduct testing on Visitors at this time. We are able to provide self- test kits if you are unable to obtain a test on your own or do not have a valid proof of a negative test conducted in the required time frame.

If you suspect exposure to someone who is ill or who has recently tested positive for COVID-19, or you are not feeling well yourself please do not visit.

In accordance with CMS LTC Facility Testing Requirements, all staff that is not “up to date” with all recommended COVID-19 vaccines, including any booster dose(s) when eligible, will have to routine test. The frequency of testing is based on the Queens County level, which is currently high, requiring staff to be tested twice (2) a week.

As per NYSDOH mandate and as an effort to communicate current statistics and COVID-19 related information, Chapin Home would like to notify you of the following.
